

Alcohol and Drug Prevention Efforts at Randolph College

At Randolph College we utilize policy, protocol, and educational programming to create a social environment that puts student safety first.

College alcohol and drug policies are reviewed throughout the academic year and are updated to address the needs and concerns of the campus community. In addition, modifications to our disciplinary protocol are made when necessary in order to ensure that College policies are implemented and enforced in constructive ways.

In addition, Randolph College is committed to providing students with the tools they need to make smart social decisions. During the fall semester, every first-year student is required to complete the on-line course AlcoholEdu with a passing grade of 80%. We provide alcohol programming during New Student Orientation each August, and the Residence Life staff offers additional alcohol education programs throughout the academic year. Students who present with behaviors that signal possible alcohol dependence or addiction may be referred by Dean of Students Office staff or the Social Violations Hearing Board to complete the SASSI at our Health and Counseling Center; students meet individually with a counselor to process the results of the inventory and set goals for addressing identified alcohol issues.
