Requests will be decided by the end of the first week of classes. English majors with an emphasis in creative writing who are allowed to place above ENGL 1161 will take 3 (rather than 2) of the 2200-level single-genre writing courses (2262, 2265, 2266, 2279) to complete the equivalent credit hours in the major.
